## CHARACTERISTICS OF RESIDENTIAL FARMS & RANCHES

### **ADVANTAGES**

- Natural environment provides calm, freedom
- Diversity of activities allows for the development of personal gifts and interests
- Agricultural and animal husbandry tasks build from simple to complex, and challenge the individual while building vocational skills
- Farm and ranch tasks have satisfying visible concrete outcomes
- Quiet environment soothes over-stimulated senses, reduces anxiety
- Calmer, less anxious individuals have more chance of success
- The presence of animals can be therapeutic
- Growing plants can be therapeutic
- Growing food for oneself can be motivating and fulfilling
- Animals allow individuals with disabilities to take on a caregiver role
- Eating local food and sustainable living are increasingly popular
- A variety of vocational skills grow naturally from the farm/ranch setting, and others can be added

### **DISADVANTAGES**

- Community integration must be planned and organized to avoid isolation
- Social activities must be planned
- · Community supports must be sought out and considered when locating
- The cost of land in some areas of the country is prohibitive
- Providing services within the home setting can be expensive, particularly with a smaller number of residents

#### **ISSUES**

- Sustainability in funding is a major issue, with the goal of a home for life
- The type of home available affects the funding available (group homes versus owned or rented apartments or condominiums)
- Setting guidelines for eligibility can involve difficult decisions
- Staffing, getting volunteers, and providing continuity can be difficult
- Providing adequate therapies, activities, and rehabilitation all within the home setting can be daunting and an organizational challenge.
