


Entitlement - Healthcare








Sample Social Security Statement (partial) Your Estimated Benefits




*Retirement	At your full retirement age (65 years), your payment would be about	\$1,000 a month
*Family	If you get retirement or disability benefits, your spouse and children also may qualify for benefits.	
*Survivors	You have earned enough credits for your family to receive survivors benefits. If you die this year, certain members of your family may qualify for the following benefits.	
	Your child	\$800 a month
	Total family benefits cannot be more than	\$1,800 a month




Stage 1: PWD Turns 18 parents still working




Stage 2: Parents retire with social security work record

Helpful Hints

• Learn the group health insurance laws for your state

Beware: self-insured plans not subject to state law

 Be sure to keep your annual statement
- Benefits change–keep up with the laws







How should your attorney set up the trust?


- Not IN your will
